MEDICINE WASTE

The cost of medicines

The annual bill for medicines prescribed by the East Surrey GPs is £22.5m and the target is to reduce this by £2m in the current year.



What is the most costly NHS medicines?

An **unused medicine** is the most costly, and it is estimated that the cost of these in East Surrey could be around £860,000 each year. Studies have shown that up to half of all patients do not take their medicines as recommended.

What can patient and carers do to help?

- Make sure you attend regular medication reviews.
- Always take your medication as prescribed by your doctor.
- Discuss your medication with your GP regularly.
- Think before you tick! Order only the medicines you need.
- Return any unwanted medicines to your pharmacy for safe disposal.
- Take your medicines with you if you go into hospital.

The importance of correct disposal

Unused medicines, even if unopened, cannot be reused by another patient and can pose a safety risk, particularly to children, if kept at home.

Incorrectly discarded medications have an impact on the environment. A recent audit has shown that 21% of patients dispose of waste medicines in the dustbin and 10% flush them down the toilet. Unused medicines returned to pharmacies are incinerated.

ANNUAL FLU CAMPAIGN

The annual flu campaign is well underway. If you have not had your annual flu vaccination and are in one of the 'at risk' groups, please book your appointment. Leaflets in the surgery will explain who is entitled to a free flu vaccination. To date 2,200 patients have been vaccinated.

FESTIVE SEASON MEDICATION

We are coming close to the festive period so please make sure you do not run out of your medication over the Christmas and New Year period.

WHAT IS NHS III?

If you need medical help fast but not a life-threatening situation, you can now call **NHS III.** When you call III, a trained adviser will ask you questions to find out what is wrong, give you medical advice and direct you to someone who can help you, like an out of hours doctor or a community nurse.

When to use III

Call III if you need medical help fast, but it's not life-threatening - for example, if you:

- think you need to go to hospital
- don't know who to call for medical help
- don't have a GP to call
- need medical advice or reassurance about what to do next.

For health needs that are not urgent, you should call you GP.

You should only call 999 in an emergency - for example, when someone's life is at risk or someone is seriously injured or critically ill.

KINGS ROAD CAR PARK

The Birchwood Patient Group were asked to make a statement by the Surrey Mirror re the development of the car park in Kings Road. The following statement was given:

"The Birchwood Patient Group is aware that the two busy GP surgeries, associated clinics and the pharmacy in Kings Road result in the existing car park on the library site being heavily used. The Council must also be aware of this from the revenue collected and would be expected to ensure that the facility is preserved, or even extended, as part of any proposed development."
